**B. Elementary Presentations – Plans for Improving Student Achievement**

The Plans for Improving Student Achievement include four major components: description of current performance levels, comparison of current data to previous data, description of strategies utilized during the past school year, and strategies that will be implemented in the current school year to improve student achievement. Several revisions have been made in the format of the Plans since last fall, including adding the Academic Performance Index (API).
