B. Elementary Presentations – Single Plans for Student Achievement

Each fall, for the past four years, principals presented Plans for Improving Student Achievement to the Board and the public at a Board meeting. These presentations were part of a comprehensive process designed to increase student achievement levels. The Plans included a thorough review of the data and the strategies used to improve student achievement.

The enactment of the No Child Left Behind federal law requires that each site prepare a Single Plan for Student Achievement. Because so many features of this plan match what has been done in the past, the Single Plan for Student Achievement has replaced the former Plan for Improving Student Achievement.

At this meeting, the elementary principals will present their school's Single Plan for Student Achievement. On October 22, the secondary principals will present their single plans.
