Background

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing has eliminated the use of emergency credentials. One of the credentials that bridges this gap is called a provisional internship permit. It is a requirement of the Commission on Teacher Credentialing that these be approved as an action item, in order for the Commission to issue the credential.

As you are aware, we have had trouble hiring fully credentialed Special Education teachers this year and have had mid-year turnover. . At La Cumbre Jr. High, we have had turnover in the area of Special Education and had a teacher resign right before the Christmas break. We offered a candidate the position, and they declined. Kerry Minadeo, a long term substitute teacher in our District as well as a previous Special Education instructional Assistant, is pursuing his teaching credential. We are asking for a Provisional Internship Permit for him to cover him through the end of the 2007-08 school year.
