Background

In collaboration with a local artist, Diana Rigsby Herrin, La Cuesta Continuation High School and the Community Day School plan to provide its students with 10 art classes during the second semester of the school year.

Plan

La Cuesta and CDS plan to offer 10 art classes, emphasizing "recycled art" with scrap wood. The classes will take place on the La Cuesta and CDS campuses.

Diana Rigsby Herrin Art Classes
for La Cuesta Continuation High School
and Community Day School
PROPOSAL FOR 2007-2008

Summary of class format:

- A session of up to 10 art classes on Friday afternoons during the Spring semester for La Cuesta Las Alturas (12:00 to 1:00) and Community Day School (1:15 to 2:15).
- The classes in “Recycled Art” will focus on using discarded scrap wood and transforming it into works of art, using five simple steps to create something useful and beautiful.
- Art classes will be provided by Diana Rigsby Herrin, a local entrepreneur who formerly operated a cottage industry in the Monterey Bay area, was featured in *Traditional Home* magazine, and creates window displays for *Kids by the Sea* in Carmel, Ca.

Cost of Program:

Diana Rigsby Herrin’s pay rate is \$30.00/hour

12 teaching hours per class

12 planning hours per class

24 hours/session x \$30.00/hour= **\$720.00/class**

Cost of materials: **\$50.00/class**

Total: \$770/class

Total for 2 classes: \$1540
