Subject: **Notice of Public Hearing and Approval of Resolution 09/10-07 Regarding Sufficiency of Instructional Materials for Cleveland School and the Santa Barbara Community Academy**

Action Item: X (Time Required: 10 minutes)

Background

California Education Code Section 60119 (as revised by Chapter 118, Statutes of 2005 and California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 5, Section 9531) states that in order to be eligible to receive instructional materials funds, the governing board of each elementary district is required to hold an annual public hearing before the end of the eighth week from the first day pupils attend school for that year and adopt a resolution stating whether each pupil in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are aligned to the academic content standards and are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the State Board of Education (SBE) in Reading/Language Arts/English Language Development, Mathematics, History/Social Science, and Science.

Findings

A review of the instructional programs at Cleveland School and the Santa Barbara Community Academy for 2009-2010 has determined that the Santa Barbara Elementary School District has provided both schools sufficient State Board of Education-adopted textbooks in Reading/Language Arts/English Language Development, Mathematics, History/Social Science, and Science.

Please note that though Cleveland School and the Santa Barbara Community Academy are using a reading language arts textbook from the 2002 adoption list that expired November 2008 and are no longer state adopted, districts may continue to use them to meet the sufficiency requirements of EC Section 60119. However, the Instructional Materials Funding Realignment Program (EC Section 60422) requires that newly adopted materials be purchased by the start of the fall term no later than 24 months after a SBE adoption.

The title and publisher of each State Board of Education-adopted textbook for each core instructional area in use at Cleveland school and the Santa Barbara Community Academy is attached.

Fiscal Impact

None at this time.

Recommendation

That the Board adopt Resolution 09/10-07 stating there is a Sufficiency of Instructional Materials for Cleveland School and the Santa Barbara Community Academy for the school year 2009-2010.

RESOLUTION REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS
(Education Code Section 60119)

WHEREAS, Education Code section 60119 mandates that the governing board of every school district hold a public hearing to determine whether there are sufficient textbooks or instructional materials available to each district pupil; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Santa Barbara Elementary School District, in order to comply with the requirements of *Education Code* Section 60119 held a public hearing on August 25, 2009, at 8:30 p.m. which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Santa Barbara Elementary School District, provided at least ten days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

WHEREAS, Board of Education of Santa Barbara Elementary School District, encouraged participation by parents, teachers, bargaining unit leaders, and members of the community, in the public hearing, and;

WHEREAS, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, at Cleveland School and the Santa Barbara Community Academy, and;

WHEREAS, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects: Reading/Language Arts/English Language Development, Mathematics, History-Social Science, and Science, and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that for the 2009-2010 school year, the Santa Barbara Elementary School District has provided each pupil at Cleveland School and the Santa Barbara Community Academy with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks.
