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## High School Students Dual-Enrolled at SBCC by High School, Ethnicity and Gender Fall 2005 – Spring 2009

Santa Barbara and Dos Pueblos have the largest dual-enrollment populations, and these two schools combined account for approximately 55-60% of all dual-enrolled students in SBCC courses. White and Latino students make up the two largest dual-enrolled ethnic groups, averaging 58% and 28%, respectively, across terms. Overall, the enrollment by gender is almost equal, with slightly more females (average 52% across terms) than males (48%).
