K-12 Teachers

Aeries/Google Apps: A one-day training in which participants will learn the various pieces of the Google program: gmail, google calendar, google documents, and google sites. Participants will learn how to create and share the different documents, calendars, and sites. Aeries training will have an overview of the fundamentals of Aeries.net and Aeries gradebook. Recommended for 4-12th grade teachers (any content area).

Dates: Mon., June 7th

AVID ELL: A one-day training in which participants will learn strategies that will support the acquisition of English. Recommended for 4-12th grade teachers (any content area).

Date: Fri., June 11th

Edusoft Training: A one-day training in which participants will learn how to disaggregate data, create intervention groups, develop assessments based on data, and integrate Examview with Edusoft. Recommended for 4-12th grade teachers (any content area).

Date: Mon., June 7th

Introduction to Pre-AP and Differentiation: A one-day training that is designed to equip all middle and high school teachers with the strategies and tools to engage their students in active, high-level learning, thereby ensuring that every middle and high school student develops the skills, habits of mind, and concepts needed to succeed in college. Recommended for 6-10th grade teachers of all content areas.

Portal/Moodle Technology Training: A one-day training presented by Santa Barbara County Education Office. Participants will learn how to use the portal and it's resources to better their instruction in all content areas. Recommended for 4-12th grade teachers (any content area).

Pre-AP Vertical Teaming (content specific): A two-day training for 6-10th grade content teachers to facilitate and create a curriculum that uses the strategies and

tools to propel students into AP courses and college.

Read 180 Classroom Management and Resources:

A one-day training that will focus on procedures, strategies and supplemental resources that work! Students will be more focused, involved and engaged. Recommended for Read 180 teachers that have gone through the SB472 training.

Science Collaborative Project (Pre-AP Vertical Teaming):

A four-day workshop for 6-12th grade science teachers led by CollegeBoard and AVID. Teachers will articulate in feeder patterns to create a pipeline for all students.

Start the School Year Right and Time to Teach by Scott Purdy:

Three one-day trainings will be offered. The *Start the School Year Right* workshop will have participants plan, set, and discover efficient ways to accomplish the goals to get them through the most important part of the school year: the first three weeks. The *Time to Teach* workshop will teach valuable time management tips for balancing a professional and personal life.

Elementary Teachers

AVID Elementary: A two-day training with a focus on the four Quality Standards of Organization, Agenda, Note-taking and Levels of Inquiry. The completion of both days will satisfy the mandate that all 4-6 grade teachers must be trained either at Summer Institute or at other trainings. Recommended for 3-6th grade teachers.

Dates: Tues. & Wed., June 8-9th

EnVision Math: A one-day training that will encompass four different sessions. The sessions are: Universal Access, Online Resources, Enrichment Materials, and Assessments to Drive Instruction.

Recommended for elementary teachers that have been through the SB472 training.

Dates: K-2 Mon., June 7th & 3rd-6th

Secondary Teachers

AVID Implementation: Two-day training for JHS and HS AVID elective teachers. This training will meet the criteria for AVID elective teachers to attend at least 2 years of training at Summer Institute. For new and experience AVID elective teachers.

Career Tech Education: Recommended for JHS and HS Career Tech Teachers.

Dates: Mon. & Tues., June 7-8th

Critical Reading and Writing with Jonathan LeMaster

- One day training designed 4-12 grade teachers that are new to AVID Critical Reading and Writing. *Date: Thurs., June 10th*
- One day training designed for 9/10th grade ELA teachers that have had experience working with the strategies. *Date: Fri., June 11th*
- One day training designed for 4-12 grade Social Studies/Science teachers that have had experience working with the strategies. *Date: Sat., June 12th*

Holt Math for 9/10th grade teachers: A three-day training for algebra and geometry teachers who have not attended SB 472. The workshop includes a focus on curriculum development, pacing calendar and assessment.

Library Media Teacher Training: A two-day training with a focus on 2.0 WEB. Recommended for librarians.
