STUDENT TEACHERS

The Governing Board is legitimately interested in the quality of teacher training programs and encourages the use of student teachers/university interns in the districts. Such use shall support the instructional needs of the districts and may enable future teachers to fulfill state requirements, learn how to teach, and receive valuable feedback that can enhance their competence.

The Superintendent or designee may enter into agreements with accredited colleges and universities to allow student teachers/university interns to have supervised teaching experiences and/or observations within the districts. The Superintendent or designee may collaborate with the program administrators of teacher preparation institutions to jointly develop, supervise and evaluate practical programs which provide training, support and evaluation for the student teacher/university intern.
