Instruction

PART-TIME ENROLLMENT OF JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING

Selection of Students

1. A student capable of benefiting from advanced scholastic or vocational training may, with written permission of parent or guardian, apply to the principal of the school in which he or she is enrolled requested permission for part-time enrollment in an institution of higher learning. Such request, with evidence of acceptance by the institution, shall be submitted no later than six weeks prior to the semester in which such enrollment is anticipated.
2. The principal shall determine whether or not the advanced learning experience is available at any of the junior or senior high schools of the district. The principal shall also determine whether the student is sufficiently gifted or talented to assure significant achievement in the course for which enrollment is proposed. Assurance shall be determined that the advanced learning experience will not jeopardize the student's attendance or progress at the school of regular enrollment.
3. The principal's recommendation for approval or rejection of the request shall be forwarded to the Assistant Superintendent of Secondary Education for review and potential endorsement or rejection.
4. Upon approval of the Assistant Superintendent, the Business Office will arrange for payment of claims to reimburse the community college district for current expenses incurred on account of attendance of Santa Barbara High School District students from grades 7 through 10.

Limitations

1. Such part-time enrollment may be in lieu of school courses provided attendance at the regular school is not less than the required minimum day (four periods).
2. Approval shall be limited to one semester per request. The Assistant Superintendent or his/her designee is authorized to approve renewal or continuation upon receipt of evidence of the student's satisfactory progress in the advanced study.

Consistent with the Board of Education's philosophy of encouraging each student to develop to his or her maximum potential, the Superintendent is authorized to enter into agreements with appropriate institutions of higher learning to provide opportunity for part-time enrollment to a limited number of qualified student's currently enrolled in schools of the Santa Barbara High School District.

Authorization for such advanced study shall require approval of the parent or guardian, the principal and the Assistant Superintendent. It may include enrollment in:

- College or university classes at no expense to the district;
- Community college for students of grades 11 and 12 for which the college receives ADA at no expense to the District;
- Community college for students of grades 7 through 10 for which the school district shall reimburse the college for current expenses incurred as defined in the California Education Code.
