Instruction

ELEMENTARY/JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

In order to recognize successful completion of elementary and junior high school education, the Governing Board shall confer certificates of promotion from elementary and junior high schools.

(cf. 5127 - Graduation Ceremonies and Activities)

Certificates of promotion shall be awarded only to students who have completed the course of study prescribed by law and the district. (Education Code 51402)

In addition, students shall meet district requirements for promotion based on grades, assessments or other indicators as specified in Board policy and administrative regulation.
