## **Board Policy**

**BP 6176**

### **Instruction**

#### **PART-TIME ENROLLMENT OF JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS IN INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING**

Consistent with the Board of Education's philosophy of encouraging each student to develop to his or her maximum potential, the Superintendent is authorized to enter into agreements with appropriate institutions of higher learning to provide opportunity for part-time enrollment to a limited number of qualified students currently enrolled in schools of the Santa Barbara High School District.

Authorization for such advanced study shall require approval of the parent or guardian, the Principal and the Assistant Superintendent. It may include enrollment in:

- College or university classes at no expense to the district;
- Community college for students of grades 11 and 12 for which the college receives ADA at no expense to the district;
- Community college for students of grades 7 through 10 for which the school district shall reimburse the college for current expenses incurred as defined in the California Education Code.
