Measure I-98

An update on the Santa Barbara Elementary School District's Measure I-98 bond-funded modernization, renovation, and new construction projects.

Bond Project Schedule: 2000-2003

Several bond-funded projects were completed in the 2000-2001 school year. Staff and the architects are working on developing plans and specifications for projects to begin in June 2002. The Board of Education has recently voted to expand the Santa Barbara Community Academy into the space currently being occupied by the District Administration Office. This expansion and renovation will also be included as a future Measure I-98 project.
