Mr. Beutel reviewed the updated report with the committee.

## **6. Financial Update**

Ms. Avnit was unable to attend. Mr. Hetyonk distributed an updated financial report and indicated it had no new pertinent information.

## **7. Site Reports –Architects, Principals, Project Manager**

Mr. Wilcox and Mr. Mayrose provided information regarding construction at various school sites. Amongst items reported were:

San Marcos High School

- Campus modernization 22% complete
- Gymnasium 98% complete
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) improvements 23% complete

Santa Barbara High School (SBHS)

- Elevator project 88% complete
- Modernization, phase II 88% complete
- Theater contract was awarded–  
SBHS Theater Foundation is funding \$117,300 for the seating. Eighty percent of this has been provided to the district. The foundation is also paying for a percentage of the architect fees. They will continue to fundraise.  
The school site is funding the refinishing of the floors.  
Access to Eddie Mathews field 60% complete.

La Cuesta High School

Modernization drawings are at the Division of State Architect for review.

Dos Pueblos High School

- Theater is 78% complete. Construction should be completed by September
- Elling's Aquatic Center 98% complete. Construction should be complete by June

Santa Barbara Junior High School

- ADA improvements are 35% complete

La Cumbre Junior High School is complete.

Goleta Valley and La Colina junior high schools have ADA upgrades. Ninety-five percent of this work is complete.

## **8. Future Agenda Items**

Board president Harter inquired what the committee's thoughts were in regard to bond refinancing. Mr. Hetyonk indicated if the board of education approved the refinance the monies would be used to first finish the construction projects on the board approved priority list and he would then return to the board for further direction. Mr. Zoradi inquired if the districts had received a response from the California State Attorney General in regard to the legality of using the refinance money, rather than returning it to the home owners. Mr. Diaz indicated they had not yet received word from the attorney general, and added that the attorney general would not address the legality of keeping the funds.

Superintendent Sarvis requested the bond refinancing topic be added to the next BOC agenda for further discussion.
