



## PESTICIDE NOTICE TO PARENTS

Pursuant to the Healthy Schools Act of 2000, the district is required to notify staff, parents, or guardians of the name of all pesticide products, expected to be applied at the school facility during the upcoming year. Those products are listed on the attachment.

It is the goal of the district to provide a safe, clean and healthful environment for students and staff. Our list for the 2002/2003 school year contained twenty-two items. This list is now down to five pesticides. Through a combination of techniques, such as improving sanitation, employing mechanical & physical controls and working with our Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Advisory Committee, we have dramatically reduced the use of chemical pesticides while providing better, longer-lasting control of pests.

Examples of alternative, non-toxic methods are eliminating available food, water, hiding places and entry points for the suppression of pests such as rodents, using heat treatment instead of chemicals when possible for termites, utilizing hand pulling, weed eaters, torching, and mulching instead of herbicides.

**If you wish to receive notification** of individual pesticide applications at the school facility, please complete the attached registration form. You will receive notification at least 72 hours prior to the application. A sample of the notification is also attached. You will automatically be notified of any proposed use of any pesticide not appearing on the attached list.

In the event of an emergency condition (such as bees or yellow-jackets) requiring immediate action, the notification requirements can be waived. A warning sign will be immediately posted upon application and shall remain posted for 72 hours after the application. Every effort to provide the required notification for the application of a pesticide will be made.
