

# Fact Sheet: Santa Barbara High School Pool

**Inaugural Splash – April 17, 2003**

The contractor for the Santa Barbara High School pool project is J.W. Bailey Construction, a Santa Barbara company.

The subcontractor for the pool is Mission Pools of Escondido, CA. The company has built several pools in Santa Barbara County, including two swimming pools for the University of California, Santa Barbara and one pool for the Santa Barbara Rehabilitation Institute. Mission Pools completed rehabilitation work on the Los Baños pool.

- 2.2 m Cost of the pool project, funded by Measure V and community donations.
