



SPECIAL EDUCATION TEACHERS
Mild-moderate and Moderate Severe

QUALIFICATIONS:

Must possess a valid California Special Education Credential with authorization to teach students with mild/moderate and/or moderate-severe disabilities. Must have fulfilled the California Basic Educational Skills (CBEST) requirement. Candidates must have a strong background in implementing behavior management skills and modifying or adapting materials or equipment to meet each individual's needs.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

To plan, design and implement, in collaboration with both special education and general education teachers, curricular programs and instructional strategies that facilitate the successful transition/ integration of students with moderate and severe disabilities/behaviors in the least restrictive environment; to work with each student in attaining his/her learning potential.

SALARY:

Placement on the salary schedule commensurate with training and experience. Eligible to participate in district health, dental, vision, and term life insurance benefits.
